John Howitt is having several events this week as part of our commitment to truth and reconciliation and learning about the impact of residential schools, in our community and across Canada. The Alberni Indian Residential School was located not far from John Howitt Elementary and only closed in 1973. Learning about the Residential Schools Survivors Flag, Orange Shirt Day, and Truth and Reconciliation has been happening throughout September. We will be having a **Residential School Survivors Flag unveiling** on *Thursday September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023*, and we will continue our learning on Friday September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023, to honour Truth and Reconciliation Day (Saturday September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023). Orange Shirt Day is a day to honour the experiences and healing journey of residential school survivors and their families, and to commit to an ongoing process of truth and reconciliation.

Phyllis (Jack) Webstad, a former student of St. Joseph Mission Residential School (1891-1981) shared her story for the first time in 2013 as part of a commemorative event and reunion held in Williams Lake. During this event, Phyllis shared when she turned six and her granny took her to town where she bought a shiny new orange shirt with a string laced up the front to wear on her first day of school. When she arrived at St. Joseph's, the shirt was taken away from her along with her culture, her language and identity. Phyllis showed incredible courage stepping forward and began a movement that brings Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples together in a spirit of reconciliation.

Orange Shirt Day has provided a way to raise awareness of the legacy of residential schools and celebrate the resiliency of Indigenous Peoples. Wearing an orange shirt on September 30th is one way to honour Survivors and their families. Please join us in wearing orange on Thursday and Friday of this week to mark National Truth and Reconciliation Day.
