
Sally Anderson and the Read-and-Feed program for supporting our school with breakfast program food items. A big thank you to our Howitt PAC for

READING OVER THE WINTER BREAK:


A great way to spend the holidays is with a good book! We hope that our students can find some time over the Winter break to read a good fit book, read to a family member, or have someone read to them!
