School District Policies

Parents, please discuss the following school policies with your children:

- Parents are reminded government regulations ban smoking on all school grounds, including the playing fields.
- Student cell phones should be put away in school hours and may be used after school.

Electronic Devices

We recommend that students do not bring electronic devices such as digital cameras, cell phones, music players and games to school. They are easily broken, misplaced or go missing. Students and parents should be aware that staff will not be responsible for these devices. Students will be asked to keep all electronic devices in their back packs during the school day.

Bikes, Scooters and Skateboards

Students who ride bikes or scooters or skateboards to school must wear helmets for safety and legal reasons. Bikes should also be locked up at the bike rack. Students may not ride bikes, scooters or skateboards on the school grounds before school until 3:30 pm. Students should walk their bikes onto the school grounds to the bike racks.

Phoning Home

Please let your student know that the office phone is to be used for *emergency use only*. The phone should not be used for forgotten homework, forgotten clothing or shoes, or for making arrangements for play-dates. Thank you for your cooperation.

Traffic Safety Reminders

The RCMP will be enforcing all motor vehicle infractions within school zones, and would like to remind drivers of the following common concerns:

- Vehicles must not park within 6 meters of any traffic control devise, cross walk or stop sign.
- Reminder to come to a complete stop at all stop signs.

SCHOOL MEAL PROGRAM 2023-24

Dear Parent/Guardian:

School District 70 Pacific Rim is pleased that the Ministry of Education through the Community Links Program will continue to partially subsidize the School Meal Program in 2023/2024.

What is the School Meal Program?

The School Meal Program (SMP) ensures students are able to receive a nutritious lunch each school day. The meal program will start on **September 11, 2023** and continues through the school year. Parents will be asked to complete a SMP monthly consent envelope for each month their child participates in the program.

Who Will Pay For The Lunch?

Our cost for each School Meal Program lunch is currently **\$4.60/lunch** which works out to approximately **\$92/month**. We appreciate any and all contributions you are able to make. Partial payment is acceptable for parents who cannot afford the entire monthly fee. Please remit payment (cheques preferred) in the SMP Consent Envelope.

The lunch program operates on the honour system. The only record kept is a list of the total lunches served. No payment record is kept and all students participating in the program are treated equally.

The money received from parents complements funding received from the Ministry of Education's Community Links program and helps to make the program financially self-sufficient. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

How do I sign my child(ren) up for the program?

Return the completed Consent Envelope provided by the school to the office by the specified date. These envelopes are sent out every month and must be completed and returned in order to remain on the program.
