Parking Lot Drop Off Protocol/Etiquette

The UES main parking lot includes parking spots and a drop-off lane, cars must not be left unattended in the drop-off lane. Please assist us by following the drop-off process:

- 1. Parents/guardians wait in their vehicle with their child(ren) until their vehicle is at the front of the line.
- 2. Once at the front of the line and the car is "in park", the child(ren) get out of the vehicle and walk toward the sidewalk (the parent stays in the vehicle).
- 3. Once the student is at the sidewalk, the parent/guardian starts the car and drives away, leading to the cars behind to move forward and repeat the drop-off process.

It is essential that <u>anyone needing to accompany their child(ren) from the vehicle</u> onto the school ground <u>park in a parking spot or on the side of the road</u> in a designated space and then walk with their child.

Student Arrival at School

Please remind your child(ren) to approach the school by the sidewalk and do not ride or walk through the parking lot. If parked in the parking lot, students should cross the parking lot to the sidewalk and walk along the sidewalk, cross the exit of the parking lot and then walk along the school sidewalk onto the grounds. Thank you for your assistance with keeping our students safe!
