#### COURSES OFFERED IN THE 2<sup>ND</sup> SEMESTER ONLY

Attend ADSS for other classes around these Dual Credit classes

#### **Emergency Medical Responder Course** – Grade 12 (sometimes Grade 11's)

This Academic Dual Credit course is offered through a partnership between SD70 and the Justice Institute of British Columbia. This course takes place within the timetable at ADSS in 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester and will be delivered within the regularly scheduled timetable.

#### Academic Dual Credit Programs with North Island College in your Grade 12 year.

This opportunity allows you to take first year transferrable University courses at NIC while you are enrolled at ADSS. (*Your tuition is covered by the School District.*)

### FULL YEAR PROGRAMS

You do not attend ADSS for classes at all

#### Dual Credit Certificate Programs - Grade 12's (sometimes Grade 11's)

This is a full-time program that students can take during their grade 12 year. Includes Early Childhood Care and Education, Health Care Assistant, and Human Service Worker. Program schedule is set by NIC and may include daytime, afternoon, or evening courses.

#### Youth TRAIN in Trades - Grade 12's (sometimes Grade 11's)

#### Apprenticeship Technical Training

**During school hours** - This is a program that will allow you to take your first-year trades training such as: Electrical, Automotive, Welding, Professional Chef, Cabinet Making, Carpentry, and more at post-secondary institutions.

#### COURSES/PROGRAMS/OPPORTUNITIES

these courses are usually done outside of the regular timetable and completed after school hours

#### Work Experience—Grades 10,11,12

The WEX 12A & WEX 12B courses can allow you to receive 4 credits per course towards graduation for work experiences that are related to your career pathway. See Mr. Parmar if you are interested or want more info.


### Youth WORK in Trades - Grades 10,11,12

Secondary School Apprenticeships


