#### **Wellness Updates**

We continue to provide weekly wellness opportunities. In November we hosted a weekly beading workshop, vision boarding at lunch, and a Coastal Queer Alliance event. These weekly events are co-hosted with Tla-o-qui-aht youth workers. Please follow 'USS\_Wellness' on Instagram for more regular updates.

On Wednesday December 6<sup>th</sup> we have students from the VIU nursing program returning with before the P.A.R.T.Y program to provide presentations for grade 8's and 9's with information on illicit drug awareness, prescription drug misuse, and marijuana side effects and the influence on mental health. They will cover important topics such as the presence of fentanyl in drugs, peer pressure, and how to respond to an emergency.

On December 13<sup>th</sup> and 14th, we have Hillary McLeod coming to provide session 2 of the sexual health education curriculum to all students at USS. The focus of this session is consent.

On December 21<sup>st</sup> the Wellness program will be supporting a school-wide lunch. The food will be made by Ms. Daley's grade 9 foods course, served by the student council, and songs sung by student volunteers.
