Superintendent's Report May 11, 2021

2021/22 Staffing Update

Pleased that James Messenger has been selected as Director of Instruction – Learning and Innovation effective August 1, 2021, and tomorrow we are conducting interviews for the principal position at Ecole Alberni Elementary. First postings for teacher staffing will be distributed later this week and yearend Education Assistant staffing processes are in their early stages.

Vaccinations in Schools

COVID19 vaccination process for employees is going well and we are quickly working through SD70 staff and those who regularly work in schools. Very impressed with the vaccination plan and very grateful for health staff and volunteers who are working on the vaccination rollout. Looking forward to the program being expanded to school aged individuals.

Given vaccination rollout and possibility of students 12+ being vaccinated, a lot of planning for 2021/22 anticipates a 'normal' startup to the upcoming school year, yet we still await word from Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health in terms of potential changes to Health and Safety Guidelines or operational requirements. Most notable is whether or not cohorts will continue through the 2021/22 school year as they have a strong impact on scheduling at the secondary level, and the extent to which enhanced cleaning protocols will be required and funded next year.

Graduation & Year End activities

Public orders regarding large gatherings remain in effect for the next couple of weeks meaning secondary schools will continue to find alternate ways to celebrate graduation. Health and Safety protocols and travel restrictions also mean that many elementary schools will be finding different ways to celebrate the end of their school year, foregoing many of those trips to East Coast beaches in favour of activities closer to home and where bus transportation is less of a factor.
