We want to support Port Alberni and students who demonstrate a balanced lifestyle and will pursue a first-year post-secondary education in any of the following STEM and trades fields of study:

Who is eligible to apply
Grade 12 students attending Alberni District Secondary School:
1. Planning to attend a post–secondary institution in Canada, or
2. Planning to enroll in a pre-apprenticeship program or an entry-level trades training program at a vocational school, community college, university college, or institute within British Columbia for electrician, mechanic, construction trade, millwright, machinist, power line technician, or electronics technician.
3. Enrolled in a post-secondary institution program by September 2025.
To benefit as many families as possible, the scholarships are one–time awards, and only one child per family may receive any BC Hydro scholarship in a given year. Previous recipients of any BC Hydro scholarship are not eligible.
Application criteria
The following documents are required to complete your application package:
☐ 1. Completed and signed application form.
☐ 2. Reference letter from a teacher.
☐ 3. A well-structured cover letter demonstrating your goals and achievements, and how you intend to apply them to your future educational goals.
☐ 4. A current resume.
☐ 5. Copy of Grade 11 transcripts and any Grade 12 transcripts to date. Academic history must demonstrate a minimum 'B' or 3.0 grade point average.
☐ 6. Essay: In 300 words or less, describe your involvement in a current or recently completed project that focuses on

Application package deadline: Please send your completed scholarship package, including the six attachments, to your school counsellor by May 15, 2025.

How selections are made

The applications received by the deadline will proceed to the next evaluation step. Applications will then be evaluated by school representatives and a BC Hydro representative based on the following criteria:

- 1. A minimum academic standing of a 'B' or 3.0 grade point average.
- 2. Noteworthy achievements and participation in school or community activities, as demonstrated in the student's application package.
- **3.** A 300-word or less essay describing the student's involvement in a current or recently completed project that focuses on: energy conservation, safety, trades, or youth STEM programming.

A school representative will contact each applicant by letter to advise of the status of their application by the end of May. Successful scholarship recipients will receive a letter containing further details to process the scholarship funds.

Scholarship payment guidelines

- O Scholarships are for the September 2025 to April 2026 school year only and cannot be deferred to the next school year.
- O Payment process: Scholarship award payments are sent directly from BC Hydro to the financial offices at the post–secondary institution the applicant will attend. Once an institution receives the scholarship funds, they are processed based on their accounting practices. The payments must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions in cash or otherwise.
- O Timing of payment—September: Scholarship payments are credited to the recipient's student account by the end of September.
- O Due to the administration process, this scholarship cannot be released in time for tuition fee deadlines.
