3100: ACCESS TO SCHOOLS BY OUTSIDE AGENCIES (AP)

POLICY

The Board of Education recognizes that a variety of outside agencies and individuals may consider the school system as a convenient and reasonable access to potential clients.

Generally, the Board will not permit the school system to be used as a vehicle for the distribution of information by commercial agencies or entrepreneurs. Where a proposed activity is deemed to be of significant advantage to all the students of a school(s), approval for distribution of information will be governed by the Regulations to this policy or by specific approval of the Board.
