- Clothing or footwear required for school sports and other school activities

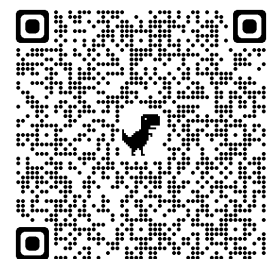
To access this support you may do any one of the following:
