Also, if you have a copy of your Kindergarten class (with the school's name, if not displayed in the picture) or a group photo of you on a sports team, please feel free to submit those.

4. GRAD SCRIPT WRITE-UP

As you walk across the stage at your graduation ceremony in June 2024, your name will be called, and a short statement will be read out. This is a very important day for you and your family. So, you get to write the statement. We will edit the statement, as needed, for brevity, clarity, and content - but you get to create the message. You only get to do this once in your life, so it's certainly a good idea to put some extra thought, care, and attention into it. Inappropriate content will result in your submission being discarded. This, or failure to submit the form in a timely manner, will mean that admin staff will create a generic (therefore boring!) statement about you.

She would like to thank her parents for their endless support, and for being her #1 fans. Finally, she would like to thank her coaches Mr. Parmar, Mr. Bill, and Mrs. Jack for their mentorship.

This is what will be added beside your Grad photo in the Yearbook.



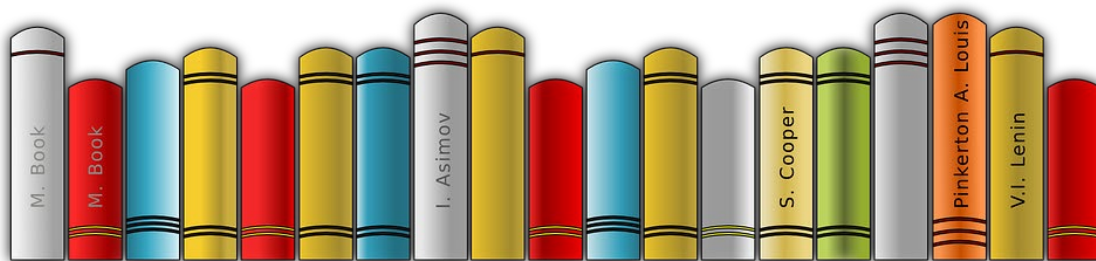
How will you remember your time at ADSS? What’s your Grade 12 message? Is there anyone to thank? Some ideas to consider are:
