



\$3500 MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be senior high school students applying for admission to a recognized university music program or an accredited private performing arts music program in 2026.

Selection Criteria

Applicants must submit:

- A 500-word statement demonstrating their commitment to a future career in music
- Supporting documents outlining musical achievements and experience
- Two letters of reference

Application Deadline

The deadline for applications is **April 15, 2026**

Auditions

By May 15, 2026, all selected candidates will be invited to participate in a juried public audition to be held in June 2026 (date to be determined).

Students are encouraged to showcase **three contrasting musical pieces** that demonstrate technical and interpretive skills across a variety of styles.

Selection Process

Adjudicators representing each discipline will determine the successful candidate. The selected candidate will receive **\$3,500** toward their first-year tuition in a university music program or an accredited private performing arts music program.

- Grade 12 student in high school or equivalent, as recommended by a private, accredited music teacher.

Application Requirements:

- A 500-word written essay that demonstrates your commitment to a career in music.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with your musical achievements and goals (family members excluded).
- An in-person interview with the committee.
- The most recent high school grade transcript.
- A letter of acceptance into a recognized university music program or an accredited private performing arts music program in 2026. (as soon as possible).
