

Parksville Quilt House Quilters' Guild Scholarship Selection Criteria  
2023 - 2024

The applicant must

1. be either graduating this year or have graduated in the previous school year from a secondary school in District 68 (Nanaimo/Ladysmith), 69 (Parksville/Qualicum Beach), 70 (Pacific Rim), or 71 (Courtenay/ Comox)

or

be a member, or spouse, child or grandchild of a member in good standing with the guild

2. be pursuing a degree or a diploma in textile arts or fashion design.  
A degree or diploma in Fine Arts and Graphic Design will be considered if the candidate demonstrates that these will be related to fibre/textile arts or fashion design
3. demonstrate, by means of a portfolio, their interest in fibre/ textile Arts or fashion design
4. currently be at, or have identified, a program at an accredited Canadian post-secondary institution
5. The applicant preferably will have completed a course of study in textiles or fashion design

In addition to meeting the criteria, the candidate must provide a

1. transcript of grades for grade 11 and 12 courses
2. letter of recommendation from a teacher
3. letter from the applicant indicating
  - why he/she deserves the scholarship
  - plans for education and subsequent career
  - plans for affiliation with the Guild, if any

- your affiliation, if any, with the Guild

To receive scholarship monies, you will be required to forward to the Guild proof of attendance at an accredited Canadian post-secondary institution and your Social Insurance Number within 27 months of June 30<sup>th</sup> of your graduating year.
