For the majority of these Scholarships or Bursaries, **you must be starting a post-Secondary program or taking post-Secondary courses in the year following your graduation.** Many groups will **NOT** hold the award for you if you decide to take a gap year. Please consider this before you apply.

REMEMBER: “Scholarships” are not restricted to the “A” students...a good C+ average will be considered. Also, most awards are given to students proceeding to **ANY** post-secondary institution, which includes University, College, BCIT, or Vocational Institutions. Also, a considerable amount of money is available in the form of bursaries that depend more on financial need or volunteer work & community involvement, rather than on high marks. Some of the scholarships have specific criteria. For example:

If you receive an award, please be sure to write a thank you letter promptly – before the end of the summer.

Most of these organizations & donors consist of volunteer members who put in a lot of time and effort to generate the funds that provide these Scholarships & Bursaries.

Contact information will be given to you when you receive your Award Certificate.

1. **What do I do first?**

Read the List of Scholarships and Bursaries and select those for which you are qualified.

NOTE: You must state how or why you are qualified in the FIRST space on page 1 of the Scholarship Application. Please thoughtfully answer this one – donors pay attention to how you answer it! DO NOT JUST ANSWER WITH “I qualify because I am going to post-secondary and am in need of financial support”

2. **Does the Scholarship Require a Specific Application?**

Some do, those Scholarships or Bursaries will be marked with an **S**. These separate applications are posted in the Grad Section of our ADSS Website (Grad – Scholarships & Bursaries). Your application for that Scholarship or Bursary will not be considered if this is not included in your package.

3. **What do I need to send with my application form?**

Each package should include -IN THIS ORDER

- **COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM** – Make sure YOUR NAME is filled in
- **PARAGRAPH OR ESSAY**
 - *(Only if specifically requested)*
- **PERSONAL LETTER**
 - *(A sample of the personal letter is available in the Career Centre and posted on our school website. Also, please be sure to sign your letter)*
- **YOUR UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT**
 - *(Obtain from ADVISING CENTER. – use the MyEd version NOT the one you can download from the Ministry of Education. The Ministry of Education one lists “Reasons for Non-Graduation, and while you know these are courses that you are working on completing prior to Grad, many donor groups are confused by that list of courses and may think that you are not actually going to Graduate this year)*
- **MARKS COLLECTION FORM**
 - *(For Semester 2 courses you are currently taking, signed by your teachers)*
- **RESUME**
- **REFERENCE LETTER(S)**

4. **Should I hand-print or type my applications?**

Most donors prefer that your application form is typed as printed ones are often hard to read. The application form is on our school website as a fillable form that can be easily typed into. Please note: There may be a request for handwritten information – read instructions carefully.

- ❖ **Put the completed application form at the front and staple everything together.**
- ❖ **Please only use ONE STAPLE.**
- ❖ **Do not put in an envelope or duo tang.**
- ❖ **Use regular 8.5 x 11 paper for your packages – no legal sized paper.**

ALBERNI DISTRICT COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS *(In Memory of Mr. Harold E. Turner)*

These 4 Awards are open to members and members' children, grandchildren, or guardian. Applicants must give the qualifying member's name and member's CO-OP number on the application under "Qualification for scholarship, be specific". Must be registered at ADSS in grade 12, or student of EALC, planning to attend any post-secondary institution starting within fifteen months of graduation. Academic achievement, school and community involvement and need will be considered. **Write a brief essay of at least 100 words on "What is the Alberni District Cooperative Association"? How is it important to you, your family and members of the community? (You must complete the essay to be considered.)** All applicants will receive a \$10 gift card for any Alberni District CO-OP location. **EALC Eligible.**

ALBERNI DISTRICT TEACHERS' UNION BURSARIES

Awarded to graduating students who plan to pursue post-secondary education in the academic year immediately following high-school graduation. This bursary is primarily based on financial need. Academic achievement, school involvement, and community participation will also be taken into consideration. Preference will be given to dependents of current or retired ADTU members.

ALBERNI DISTRICT TEACHERS' UNION SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to graduating students who plan to pursue post-secondary education in the academic year immediately following high-school graduation. Preference will be given to dependents of current or retired ADTU members. Selection will consider academic performance and financial need, as well as school involvement and community engagement.

ALBERNI VALLEY CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE – HOLY FAMILY/NOTRE DAME CHURCH BURSARY

Awarded to a student (boy or girl) who, immediately following graduation, is enrolled in full-time studies at any post-secondary institution. Must be a CWL member, be related to a CWL member, or a parishioner at Holy Family/Notre Dame Catholic Church. Church involvement, scholastic achievement & financial need will be considered. **EALC Eligible.**

ALBERNI VALLEY PRIDE BURSARY

Awarded to a student (or students) who will be attending any post-secondary institution within 24 months of graduation. Preference will be given to a student who demonstrates leadership in supporting inclusion, participates in school SAFE Club and or Alberni Valley Pride Society board and events. Submitted with the application should be an example using any form of multimedia (text, audio, images, art, and video, etc.) demonstrating the importance of diversity and inclusion within our community. Students must provide proof of registration in the form of a receipt from a University, College, Technical, Vocational, or accredited Arts Program. **EALC eligible.**

CANADIAN MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION PORT ALBERNI BURSARY- IN RECOGNITION OF MUTUAL RESPECT AND RECONCILIATION BETWEEN FIRST NATIONS AND OTHER CULTURES

This bursary is awarded to one First Nations student and one non-First Nations student based on demonstrated actions of mutual respect and reconciliation between any First Nation and other culture in Canada. Available to any student graduating from any SD70 high school, or equivalent, at any time throughout the school year. Applicants must submit an essay of 250 – 1000 words describing what activity they engaged in, and how it was effective in showing and furthering reconciliation. Specific programs and projects may be weighted higher than general personal experiences. The activity described must be verified by a letter of support from a program or community leader who has knowledge of the activities described. The recipient must commence post-secondary studies within 18 months of the award at which time the bursary funds will be forwarded to the recipient. *Evaluation and granting of the award will be completed on a subjective basis and will be entirely within the purview and discretion of the award grantor. If no suitable applicant is chosen the award will be added to the following year's available bursary. **EALC Eligible.**

CUPE LOCAL #118 BURSARY (CITY OF PA & PARKS & REC. EMPLOYEES)

Must be a dependent of, or a member of, Local 118, proceeding to any post-secondary institution starting within 15 months of graduation. Financial need and marks will be considered. **EALC eligible.**

CUPE LOCAL #118 (CITY OF PA & PARKS & REC. EMPLOYEES) "IN MEMORY OF MONA COLCLOUGH"

The student must be a dependent, or a member of Local #118. Proceeding to any post-secondary institution. Starting within 15 months of graduation. Financial need. Marks will be considered. Volunteering is an asset. **EALC eligible.**

CUPE LOCAL #3403 (COMMUNITY SOCIAL SERVICE & MENTAL HEALTH)

Awarded to a student continuing their education within 18 months of graduation. Applicants will be considered with future plans to pursue a career in the social and human service worker field. All applicants will be considered, with preference being given to CUPE 3403 members and their dependents. Financial need and future plans will also be considered, and proof of enrolment will be required to claim the funds. **Applicants are required to include a short essay on why they are choosing this field and what career they see themselves working in. EALC Eligible**

CUPE LOCAL #727 BURSARIES (SD70 EMPLOYEES)

Must be a student of a current CUPE Local 727 member in good standing, proceeding to any post-secondary institute within 18 months of graduation. Financial need, community/school service and marks will be considered.

DR. S. F. CHAN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FOR NEW CANADIANS OR STUDENTS OF IMMIGRANT PARENTS

Awarded to a student with a good record of scholastic achievement and involvement in school and/or community activities. Preference may be given to student(s) who were not born in Canada but have since immigrated with their family and may have shown perseverance in the face of adversity. Applicants must include a short paragraph describing either their family's immigration experience or why they think Canada is a great place to live and work. The recipient will be entering post-secondary education within eight months of graduation. Proof of enrolment will be required to claim the funds.

DOMTAR PORT ALBERNI (FORMERLY CATALYST PAPER EXCELLENCE)

EDNA COX SOCIAL JUSTICE BURSARY

Awarded to a student with a demonstrated interest in community development and local food security. The student is enrolled in the Social Justice class and/or works in the school garden or other community garden where they put forth maximum effort. He/she could be receiving credits for volunteer work with the Alberni Valley Transition Towns Food Action group or with organizations concerned with the disadvantaged in the community. (Ex: The Bread of Life). This student would be attending a post-secondary institution within one year of graduation. **EALC eligible.**

E.J. HUGHES BURSARY

Awarded to a resident of the Alberni Valley who is proceeding to, or continuing in, a degree, diploma or certificate program at a post-secondary institution located outside of Port Alberni, but within Canada or the USA. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and have some additional funding in place. Proof of enrolment required to claim funds. Applicants are also expected to research and learn about E.J. Hughes. Each application must include a brief statement (approximately 100 words) highlighting something they have learned about him and why it is meaningful to them. Priority may be given to a student enrolled in a dual program with ADSS and NIC.

KAMA MONEY SOCIAL JUSTICE SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a student who will be continuing their education in a field related to social work, healthcare, or political science. Awarded based on scholastic achievement. Preference will be given to students with a history of community service. Applicants are asked to submit a one-page essay stating one social justice issue in which they were involved and how it impacted them. Recipient must be registered and begin post-secondary/trades program within 2 years following graduation to claim this scholarship or bursary.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS, ALBERNI VALLEY COUNCIL #3435 BURSARIES

Awarded to a student enrolled in a full-year program at any Canadian post-secondary institution. Awards are based on satisfactory academic achievement and financial need. Candidates must demonstrate an involvement with the Community. Preference could be given to family members of Council #3435, or other Knight of Columbus councils. The recipient must enroll within 14 months of graduation from high school. Bursary will be paid after proof of enrollment.

NORA MONCUR MEMORIAL BURSARY

This bursary will be awarded to an ADSS student who plans continued education within 18 months. Monies must be claimed within 18 months of award. Student must provide proof of registration in a University, College, Technical, Vocational, or accredited Arts program. Award is based on scholastic achievement and school and/or community involvement. Must have an average of C+ or better in student's five best subjects.

NORTH ISLAND COLLEGE FOUNDATION BURSARY – DR. ALLAN DUNCAN PRITCHARD LEGACY BURSARY

Through his historic legacy gift to students, Dr. Pritchard is encouraging the next generation of students to enrich their lives, careers, and well-being through education. A lifelong learner and educator, Dr. Pritchard was also an accomplished writer, historian, cited expert on architecture, world traveler and philanthropist, but most of all, he was a kind and modest man. Today, the Pritchard legacy fund bursaries will support any student enrolled in any program at NIC. This \$1,000 bursary will be awarded to a student who will be attending North Island College (NIC) between September 2026 and February 2027. The recipient will be enrolling in post-secondary level courses (not upgrading) and will have maintained a minimum C+ average in their Grade 12 year. The funds will be applied to tuition upon registration.

Applicants are required to submit a paragraph describing why they have chosen their selected field of study.

PORT ALBERNI AND DISTRICT LABOUR COUNCIL “WALTER BEHN MEMORIAL BURSARY”

Awarded to a student at Alberni District Secondary School who will be registered in any post-secondary educational institute within eight months of graduation. Applicant must be a MEMBER OF OR LEGAL DEPENDENT OF a member of ANY union affiliated with the Port Alberni and District Labor Council (Must note which union on application). The following will be considered: marks, marks pertaining to a chosen field, plans for the future, financial need. **Must write a paragraph on what you think a Union is. If a paragraph is not included, application will be discarded. Please list union applicant or legal dependent is affiliated with.** Must be attending post-secondary education within 18 months of graduation.

ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION, Alberni Valley Branch #293 MEMORIAL Bursaries

Awarded to a son/daughter or grandson/granddaughter of a Military Service Veteran or a member of Legion Branch Alberni Valley 293 in good standing who is proceeding to a post-secondary institution. This applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution and attending in the Fall of 2026 or Spring of 2027 to be eligible for the award. The award is presented upon receipt of enrollment from the post-secondary institution is received by the Scholarship/Bursary Committee of the Alberni Valley Branch 293. **EALC eligible.**

SCHOOL BUS #1 BURSARY

Preference will be given to students who have ridden Bus #1 to or from school. Marks and/or financial need will be considered. The recipient must provide proof of enrollment to a post-secondary institution (including trades) within 18 months of graduation. **EALC eligible.**

TRUSTEE BURSARY – Pacific Rim Board of Education

This Bursary will be awarded to an individual who has a good record of achievement and is planning on attending a public post-secondary institution. It will be based on financial need, community volunteerism and/or social justice involvement. This award must be used within 18 months of graduation. Proof of registration at a post-secondary institution or trades program is required. **Students applying will need to write an essay or use a multimedia format stating one social justice issue in which they were involved and how it changed their lives.**

UNIFOR LOCAL #592 JACK BREUKER MEMORIAL BURSARY

Awarded to a member or a legal dependent of a member of Local #592. Student must be proceeding to any post-secondary institution. **Please include a letter which should have a “theme” of how your parent having a union job has affected your family.** Academic standing and personal resume will be considered.

UNIFOR LOCAL #592 DAVID FRASER MEMORIAL BURSARY

Awarded to a member or a legal dependent of a member of Local #592. Student must be proceeding to any post-secondary institution. **Please include a letter which should have a “theme” of how your parent having a union job has affected your family.** Academic standing and personal resume will be considered.

UNIFOR LOCAL #592 DARYL DEROOY MEMORIAL BURSARY

Awarded to a member or a legal dependent of a member of Local #592. Student must be proceeding to any post-secondary institution. **Please include a letter which should have a “theme” of how your parent having a union job has affected your family.** Academic standing and personal resume will be considered.

SPECIFIC ADSS PROGRAMS

CANADIAN PARENTS FOR FRENCH BURSARY (Immersion)

This bursary will be awarded to a graduating student of the French Immersion program whose family has been a member of the Canadian Parents for French prior to graduation. Applicants must have demonstrated financial need and must plan to attend a post-secondary institution within 2 years of graduation. Applications are to include a short essay written in French and answering the following questions: What benefits has the FI program provided you as a student? How will being bilingual benefit you in the future? Preference will be given to students of families with long-standing CPF memberships. Please include parent’s CPF membership number in application. Strong consideration will be given to those who have volunteered with CPF directly and to those whose families have actively participated in the CPF organization. Please provide as much detail as possible when describing your and your families’ involvement with the CPF organization. Funds will be disbursed upon proof of registration in the recipients chosen post-secondary institution. **EALC Eligible**

CANADIAN PARENTS FOR FRENCH SCHOLARSHIP (Immersion)

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating student of the French Immersion program whose family has been a member of the Canadian Parents for French prior to graduation. Applicants must show proof of academic excellence in their grade 12 year and must plan to attend a post-secondary institution within 2 years of graduation. Applications are to include a short essay written in French and answering the following questions: What benefits has the FI program provided you as a student? How will becoming bilingual benefit you in the future? Preference will be given to students of families with long-standing CPF memberships. Strong consideration will be given to those who have volunteered with CPF directly and to those whose families have actively participated in the CPF organization. Please provide as much detail as possible when describing your and your families’ involvement with the CPF organization. Funds will be disbursed upon proof of registration in the recipients chosen post-secondary institution. **EALC Eligible.**

COMMUNITY ARTS COUNCIL OF THE ALBERNI VALLEY BURSARY (Arts)

Award based on performance and achievement of the individual in the Arts, past and present, academic achievement, and financial need. **MUST** be planning a study in the Arts and **MUST** be registered. i.e.: Fine Arts, Drama, Music, Visual arts, Creative Writing. Must attend a post-secondary institution starting within eight months of graduation. (Proof of Registration is required) **EALC Eligible.**

NIKITA HEDINGHAM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Music)

Awarded to a student who has been in the ADSS Music Program and/or involved elsewhere - a smaller band, orchestra, church group, cadets etc. The recipient will be someone who will continue to play and enjoy music and hopefully bring pleasure to other people with their music after high school. On Niki's Memorial slate the family quoted from something she wrote in her Grade 10 year. She wrote, *"My family first, work hard to be the best I can be, and enjoy life."* The successful applicant should be someone who demonstrates the middle sentiment which was one of Nikita's strong points.

Please include a brief paragraph (150-200 words) that comments on Nikita’s quote as listed above.

PORT ALBERNI ORCHESTRA & CHORUS SOCIETY BURSARY (Music)

Bursary is limited to students who are entering a post-secondary music program in the Fall of 2026. Proof of acceptance to institution is required.

PORTAL PLAYERS PERFORMING ARTS BURSARY (Theatre)

Applicants must be a performing arts student, (in or outside of school). The candidate must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution of a full-time basis with intent to pursue performing arts (either performance or production). Scholastic achievement will be considered. Preference given to students who are, or have been involved with, Portal Players Dramatic Society productions or child and youth programs. The most successful candidate will be a student who best reflects our mission statement, a student who tirelessly volunteered, a student who mentors others in the arts, a student who has achieved an outstanding performance, a student with an impressive arts resume. **Please give details of Alberni Valley performing arts involvement. EALC Eligible.**

ENTERING A SPECIFIC AREA OF STUDY/CAREER FIELD

ALBERNI DENTURE CLINIC BURSARY (Dental Health-Denturism)

Awarded to a student who is pursuing studies in the field of Denturism. Proof of enrolment in a Denturist program at any British Columbian post-secondary institution. Training must be recognized by the British Columbia College of Oral Health Professionals. The recipient must enroll within 24 months of graduation from high school. Bursary will be paid after proof of enrollment. Recipients of this award will also be eligible for an additional bursary for each subsequent year (after year one,) that proof of enrollment is provided. **EALC eligible.**

ALBERNI DISTRICT RETIRED TEACHERS' BURSARY – (Education)

Awarded to a student entering a post-secondary institution within eight months of receiving the award. Must be pursuing a course of education leading to a qualified teacher's certificate. Financial need, marks, school and/or community involvement will be considered.

ALBERNI HEALTHCARE AUXILIARY BURSARY (Health Care)

Awarded to students continuing their education in the health care field, beginning within 24 months of high school graduation. (Award \$2000 in September and \$2000 in January- proof of payment required to collect funds.) Scholastic achievement and need will be considered.

ALBERNI VALLEY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE BURSARY (Business)

Awarded to a graduating student going to a university starting within eight months of graduation. Preference is given to a student that will be pursuing a Business Degree of some discipline. **EALC eligible.**

ART RAVE BURSARY (Arts)

Awarded to a graduate based on performance, achievement, and a letter of reference from an ADSS Fine Arts faculty member. Student must be planning on attending post-secondary studies in the Arts – Fine Arts, Visual Arts, Music, Graphic Arts, Media, Creative Writing, or Animation within 8 months of graduation. Proof of registration is required. **EALC eligible.**

BARRY GUS CRISIS RESPONSE MEMORIAL FUND BURSARY (Counselling, Social Work, Health Field)

This bursary will be awarded to an individual who wishes to pursue a career in a field that helps others, beginning at a post-secondary institution within fifteen months of graduation. This bursary is in memory of the late Barry Gus, who was a volunteer board of director that helped establish the KUU-US Crisis Line Society. This bursary is for any individual who is entering into a career in the helping provision to better others' lives. **EALC Eligible.**

BC HYDRO SCHOLARSHIP (Science, Engineering, Technology, Math or Trades)

Separate application located on ADSS Website: SEE ADSS WEBSITE – GRADUATION 2026 TAB – Scholarship and Bursary page for information and separate application.

S Awarded to a Port Alberni student who is a leader and role model in their school and communities. Must have demonstrated a balanced lifestyle and be pursuing post-secondary education in one of the following fields of study – science, technology, engineering, math or a trades pre-apprenticeship program. Must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution program by September 2026.

BRAYDEN ARSENAULT MEMORIAL BURSARY (Human Services/Social Work)

To be awarded to a graduating student entering post-secondary education within eight months of graduation. Proof of enrolment will be required to claim the funds. Preference will be given to students who have personally experienced challenges with mental health or have had people close to them who have experienced mental health challenges and who are pursuing further studies in the Social Work or Human Services fields. Post-Secondary study in the following programs is preferred -- Human Services–Educational Assistant/Community Support Certificate, Human Services Diploma, Social Services Diploma or Community Mental Health Worker Certificate. **Students are to include a short paragraph (250 words min.) explaining “How your experience with mental health has influenced your beliefs, relationships, and career aspirations?”** **EALC eligible.**

CAPTAIN ROB FAVEL MEMORIAL BURSARY (BCVFD) (Emergency Services)

Awarded to a student who is furthering their education in the Emergency Services field. Marks, attendance, financial need and community involvement will also be considered. Student must be registered for a program or course within 12 months of graduation. Please be sure to include a brief statement (about 200 words) that explains your reasons for wanting to continue your education in the Emergency Services field. **EALC eligible.**

GRIFFIN DOLLING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Engineering)

Awarded to a student who is pursuing post-secondary education in Engineering. Marks, attendance, community service and school citizenship will all be considered. Must be enrolled in post-secondary program within 18 months of high school graduation.

HEDIE FOURNIER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Teaching)

Awarded to an ADSS student entering a post-secondary institution within eight months of receiving the award. Must be pursuing a course of education leading to a qualified teacher’s certificate. Financial need, marks, school and/or community involvement will be considered to determine the recipient of this scholarship.

LILLIAH AND RALPH ROSSEAU MEMORIAL BURSARY (Education/Environmental Stewardship)

Awarded to a student who is proceeding to post-secondary studies in education or environmental stewardship. Student must be attending post-secondary education within 18 months of graduation. **EALC eligible.**

TRUCK LOGGERS’ ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP (Forestry/Natural Resources)

Awarded to a student graduating from **SD70 PACIFIC RIM** who is pursuing studies in the field of forestry at a post-secondary institution (degree, diploma, or trades). Other natural resource management related fields may also be considered. Recipient must be registered and begin post-secondary/trades program within the year following graduation to claim this scholarship or bursary. **EALC Eligible**

VANCOUVER ISLAND REAL ESTATE BOARD BURSARY (Real Estate)

Awarded to a student who is interested in a career in Real Estate or who is a child of a Realtor. Student must be continuing their studies within the next school year. Academic achievement and financial need will be considered.

ALBERNI VALLEY LIONS CLUB - WINSTON JOSEPH MEMORIAL BURSARY (Education)

Awarded to a student going into the teaching profession. The recipient will be enrolled in a post-secondary institution in September or January immediately following graduation. Community involvement, financial need and marks will be considered.

HOSPITAL EMPLOYEES' UNION SCHOLARSHIP (Health Careers)

Awarded to a family member of an active member of the HEU. ** Note: Not all hospital workers belong to this union. The union knows the name is deceiving. The union is 80 years old and at the time it was formed, it was primarily hospital workers. That is no longer the case - ie: Nurses belong to BCNU, some lab techs are HSA while others are HEU. Not all HEU members work in a hospital, some work in long term care or community services

Please provide the following information: HEU Member's Name, how long they've been a member, HEU site names where said member works, HEU Local Name, member's Telephone # and or email address.

TRUSTEE BURSARY – Pacific Rim Board of Education – Indigenous Learners

This Bursary will be awarded to an Indigenous Learner who has a good record of achievement and is planning on attending a public post-secondary institution. An annual scholarship awarded to a child of an active member of the Italian Canadian Society. If no applications are received from a child of a member, then a \$500 bursary will be offered to a student of Italian background or lastly, a student who has cultural background from outside of Canada who has demonstrated pride of their heritage and diversity. Bursary must be claimed with proof of registration in a post-secondary program within 14 months of graduation.

Student must be going to University and show financial need. Awarded to students based on future plans and financial need. Awarded to a student continuing to post-secondary school within 18 months of graduation. Marks, financial need, and community/church involvement will all be factors taken into consideration.

ARROWSMITH ROTARY CLUB BURSARY

Awarded to a student proceeding to any post-secondary institution within 2 years of graduation. Recipients of this award must provide a copy of their post-secondary institution course registration form prior to the funds being released to them and should be prepared to attend a Rotary Club regular meeting to acknowledge receipt of their award after the funds have been released.
